Practical suggestions for response/action:

- I will pray daily for my sisters and brothers who suffer with AIDS.
- I will seek out, pray over and discuss materials on HIV/AIDS and racism with others.
- I will notice what or how medical or other care gets provided and to whom.
- I will use my influence to educate others on the connections of HIV/ AIDS and racism.
- I will respond to advocacy opportunities on issues of race and HIV/ AIDS.



