River House IHM Spirituality Center

Rooted in the transformative life of the IHM Monroe Campus, River House-IHM Spirituality Center welcomes all who desire deeper communion with God and who share a passion for life in all its forms. We provide a sacred space for solitude, reflection, retreats and enrichment opportunities. (Mission Statement, 2014)

Retreats

Private Retreats offer a time of quiet solitude, with the freedom to follow the rhythm of your inner self and the invitation of God. For those new to this form of prayer, some "how to" suggestions can be provided.

Directed Retreats follow a pattern of solitude, prayer, reflective activities and meeting with a spiritual director. Your retreat might be planned for a few days, a week or longer, possible even 1 30-day period (Spiritual Exercises or 19th Annotation).



Guided Retreats are planned at various times throughout the year and publicized thru fliers, newspaper and the IHM webpage calendar. These retreats include presentations on specific themes, plenty of quiet time and communal discussion and/or prayer. The presentations are generally held in the HIM Motherhouse.

Overnight accommodations can be arranged through River House.

Spiritual Direction

Spiritual direction is an opportunity for individuals to talk about their lives and experiences of God with a person specifically trained in areas such as spirituality, pastoral ministry and interpersonal communication.

The spiritual director listens to the directee and together they explore the signs of God's activity in that person's life and the direction to which God seems to be calling.

We offer spiritual direction by appointment in an atmosphere of respect for people of all faith traditions who are engaged in the quest for God. To make an appointment, please call the River House office.

Service Fees

- On-going Spiritual Direction \$40-50 per session
- Retreat Direction \$30 per session

These fees may be negotiated with the director.

Accommodations

River House, situated on the banks of the River Raisin, offers four private bedrooms with attached baths, an air-conditioned meditation room, reading room, art room, two small conference rooms, full kitchen and dining room. Linens and towels are provided. All rooms have Wi-Fi internet access.
